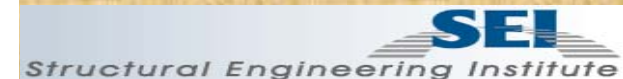

Aim and Scope

Applications of fiber reinforced polymer (FRP) in civil engineering has increased significantly in recent years, both for the strengthening of existing structures and for new construction. The aim of this conference is to provide an international forum for all concerned with the application of FRP composites in civil engineering to exchange recent advances in both research and practice.

Contents

The three-day conference (December 13-15, 2006) will be filled with a variety of session formats, with a balance of technical advancement and practicality to permit the widest possible participation, including researchers and engineers.
